• We are headquartered in Islandia, NY (Long Island) and maintain a sales office in Franklin, TN.

Who does Proxytrust serve?

- We serve community, regional, and national wealth management institutions including bank trust, private trust, and RIA firms.
- We have approximately 190 clients across 43 states.

What are Proxytrust's core services?

• We provide comprehensive proxy services for beneficial shareholders including distribution, voting, record-keeping, and custom reporting tools.

What other services does Proxytrust provide?

- Special processing for client's own bank holding company meetings.
- Prospectus and voluntary corporate action mailings.
- GoalPost Operations support for securities processing including Spin-off Direct, corporate actions research, worthless securities research, historical cost basis reporting, and date-of-death valuations.
